2023: A Year in Review

Development of Our Services

Strategy Development: Transforming Inertia into Action

Guided by our experience, we developed services around (transition) strategy development for organisations.

Whether an organisation needs help separating long-term goals from day-to-day urgencies, uncovering unseen potential, or addressing unknown strategy gaps, we developed work methods to help them by raising the right questions and identifying how the orgnisation and its team can adapt to ensure their strategy answers today's and challenges continues making a difference.

Outreach: Amplifying Influence

Effective outreach is about resonating with the audience.

We equipped ourselves to offer unique capacities to manage and coordinate multi-faceted outreach and advocacy campaigns that amplify your influence, enhance your visibility, and optimise your campaign outcomes at all levels.

The mix of our expertise on human rights issues, the rule of law, and in relation to addressing the triple planetary crisis allow us to ensure an effective campaign management.

Opportunity Identification: Seeing Potential Amidst Challenges

As unpredictability has become today's "new normal", our ability to see tomorrow's potential can be hindered.

We hence identification services that offer partners and their team an additional perspective by examining what they, immersed in day-to-day operations, might overlook.

These identification services are tailored and personalised to the needs of the partners, developed following in-depth exchanges with our partner.

Filling the Gap: Taking Matters into Our Own Hands

Where we see gaps on concerns to the core of our mission, we initiate coalitions, build movements, and generate action with our own means. We launch and seed projects and campaigns, offer our availability to partners constituting the coalitions and movements, and owning the action we will have jointly made possible.

As a cause driven advisory group, we cannot remain inactive, when we believe our contribution could make a difference.

Initial Online Campaign

In June 2023, we launched an initial online campaign, aiming at showing the particularity of our work as a cause driven advisory group. UNSR on Freedom of Association and Assembly: Civil Society is Crucial in the Selection Process


Starting in September 2023, P&C Action Lab was instrumental in initiating an informal coalition of NGOs working together on the appointment of the new United Nations Special Rapporteur on the rights to freedom of association and peaceful assembly. The coalition was coordinated by the International Center for Not-for-Profit Law (<u>ICNL</u>) and comprised of widely known and respected global and regional human rights organisations. The coalition aimed to ensure civil society input played a role in the UNSR nomination and selection process.

P&C Action Lab, represented by its President, Florian Irminger, supported ICNL's coordinator with policy advice and process insights.

The process culminated in the appointment of <u>Gina Romero</u> as special rapporteur in April 2024, to the great satisfaction of all NGOs involved in the process.

DCAF: Partnership to Strengthen Peace and Security with a Human Rights Based Approach

Through an engagement started in September 2023, Progress & Change Action Lab, represented by its President, Florian Irminger, is working with the leadership of DCAF - Geneva Centre for Security Sector Governance to develop its new strategic framework for the period 2025-2029.



The partnership involves us working closely with the steering of DCAF's strategy development process, providing guidance and assistance on a thorough internal consultation process and leading the drafting of an initial draft strategy, in addition to providing expert policy advice and external organisational on insight.

P&C Action Lab's involvement with DCAF for the strategy development ended in May 2024.

COP29: Supporting Civil Society for Climate Justice

Since November 2023, P&C Action Lab is involved in supporting several Azerbaijani human rights defenders and their organisations in developing their campaign towards the 29th United Nations Climate Change Conference, to be held in Baku, Azerbaijan, in November 2024.

On 20 February 2024, the Climate Justice Initiative was established by five Azerbaijani NGOs, namely Public Association for Assistance to Free Economy, EcoFront, Women's Empowerment Center, Election Monitoring and Democracy Studies Center, and Institute for Citizens Rights.

The detention on 29 April 2024 of human rights defender Anar Mammadli, chairperson of the Election Monitoring and Democracy Studies Center, changed the plans of the coalition, but P&C Action Lab continued to be engaged with the group and support it, in view of managing and coordinating their campaign.
